Private Group Tours FAQs

What does a private Group Tour include?

- A private guided tour includes highlights of the history and architecture of the museum, the collection, and temporary exhibitions. You can find our current and upcoming exhibitions on the [Exhibitions page on our website](#).

How long is a private guided tour?

- A guided tour lasts approximately one hour. We recommend adding 15-30 minutes at the end of the tour to revisit any gallery spaces and Museum Store.

What's the difference between a private tour and a public tour?

- Each private guided tour is assigned its own guide and can be customized to your specific interests.

How much does a tour private tour cost?

- The pricing scales for our private guided tours during public hours can be found on the [Group Tours page on our website](#).

What does the price include? Are there additional fees?

- Pricing is structured in a flat-rate pricing scale. Pricing includes museum admission, the tour, and access to our temporary exhibitions. There are no additional taxes or fees.

Is there a cafeteria or lunchroom to eat lunch in?

- The Driehaus Museum campus does not have a cafeteria or café.

Can my tour include a room for discussion afterwards?

- This may be possible depending on availability and would incur an additional fee.

Can I book a tour after the museum closes?

- Yes, depending on the museum calendar, it is possible to schedule a private tour after hours. These tours would be scheduled to start no later than 6pm and costs more than a tour during public hours.

Can I book a tour on a day not open to the public?

- Yes, depending on the museum calendar, it is possible to schedule a private tour on a day the museum is not normally open. These tours would cost more than tour during regular public hours.

Can my tour include refreshments?

- A tour with food or drinks is an event rental. Please contact events@driehausmuseum.org for rental questions.
